**DAY 1 - COCHIN TO MUNNAR TRANSFER**

You will be greeted at Cochin airport / Railway Station by our executive. You will then be driven to the quaint hill station of Munnar which is approximately a 4-hour drive from Cochin. On the way you will get a glimpse of the majestic Cheeyappara waterfalls and Valara falls. visit the Tea Museum. Learn how tea is processed from raw fresh tea leaves to its final packaging. You can also visit Munnar town and shop for spices and handmade chocolates and check into the resort. Overnight stay at Munnar.

**DAY 2- SIGHT-SEEING IN MUNNAR**

After breakfast we head out for a full day sightseeing trip to Munnar. We cover all major attractions during the day. The Mattupetty dam and Kundala lake offers visitors a boating opportunity. We also visit the echo point, top station, rose garden, hydel park and Ponthenmedu view point. After noon we visit the Eravikulam National Park famous for the Nilgiri Thar. The soft trek up the hill is worth your while as the view from up there is just breath-taking. You can also visit the Chinnakanal Waterfalls. You can also enjoy Kathakali & Martial Arts and spend the night relaxing at the resort Munnar.

**DAY 3- MUNNAR TO ALLEPPEY**

Early next morning we leave for Alleppey – “The Venice of the East”. The distance of 160+ kilometres will be covered in around 5 hours. You can board the houseboat at around 12:30pm – 1:00pm. The house boat will take you on a cruise through the Vembanadu lake. Explore the scenic backwaters while passing through lagoons, canals, lakes, rivers and inlets. You can enjoy authentic Traditional Kerala cuisine on board. Enjoy the tranquility as the boat cruises through the emerald green waters. The boat moors on the lake for the night by evening. After dark you can enjoy a delicious dinner to the sound of water lapping the side of the boat. Get a good night's sleep on the boat with the gentle sway of waters beneath you.

**DAY 4: ALLEPPEY HOUSEBOAT TO VARKALA**

After checking out from the Alleppey houseboat, proceed to Varkala (approximately 3 hours by road). Upon arrival, enjoy sightseeing in Varkala, including: Varkala Beach (Papanasam Beach): Known for its dramatic cliffs and serene atmosphere. Janardanaswamy Temple: A historic and spiritual site. Sivagiri Mutt: A prominent pilgrimage center. Varkala Cliff: Ideal for enjoying views and trying local delicacies at cliffside cafes. Kappil Lake: A tranquil spot for boating and photography. Overnight stay at Varkala

**. DAY 5: VARKALA TO TRIVANDRUM**

After breakfast, check out and proceed to Trivandrum (approximately 1.5 hours by road). On the way visit Jadavu Earth Center and proceed to Sightseeing in Kovalam includes: Kovalam Beach: Famous for its crescent-shaped shoreline and iconic lighthouse. Lighthouse Beach: Climb the lighthouse for breathtaking views of the coastline. Hawah Beach: Known for its tranquil waters and local vibes. Samudra Beach: A less crowded, peaceful spot for relaxation. Spend the evening enjoying the beaches or indulging in local cuisine. Overnight stay at Kovalam

**DAY 6 : TRIVANDRUM SIGHTSEEING**

After breakfast Enjoy Trivandrum sightseeing, including: Padmanabhaswamy Temple: A world-renowned temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu. Napier Museum: Showcasing an impressive collection of artifacts and art. Kudiramalika Palace Museum: A heritage palace with royal exhibits. Shang mugham Beach: A peaceful beach to relax. Overnight stay at Trivandrum.

**DAY 7: TRIVANDRUM TO KANYAKUMARI**

After breakfast, check out and proceed to Kanyakumari (approximately 2.5 hours by road). Explore Kanyakumari sightseeing spots, including: Vivekananda Rock Memorial: A spiritual site located on a small island. Thiruvalluvar Statue: A monumental statue dedicated to the Tamil poet. Kanyakumari Beach: The southernmost tip of India, known for its sunrise and sunset views. Bhagavathy Amman Temple: A historic temple dedicated to Goddess Kumari. Gandhi Memorial: A place where Mahatma Gandhi's ashes were kept before immersion. Overnight stay at Kanyakumari.

**DAY 8: KANYAKUMARI TO TRIVANDRUM DROP**

After breakfast, check out and proceed to Trivandrum. If time permits, visit any remaining sightseeing spots in Trivandrum. Drop off at Trivandrum Airport or Railway Station as per your schedule.
